Coaches Report:

Assessment Day Details:

There will be 10 teams of 5-6 athletes. Teams will be posted on Saturday. Whatever setup possible will take place

on Saturday afternoon. Setup will be completed early Sunday morning and the course will be set by coaches. At 9 am, teams will meet and conduct course inspection. Start at 10. Each athlete will do two runs of glalom. We will

match athletes by skill-level for glalom. Finish by 11:15. Upon finishing their second run, kids will immediately be

sent to collect their lunch. We will start again at 1, with half of participants on speed trap and half on moguls.

Athletes will do two runs on each.

We will not be acknowledging individual times but rather using combined times per team. Coaches will use

individual times to provide feedback to athletes the following week.

Rules: 5-6 athletes per team; A combined 'Team Time' will be calculated for each glalom, moguls and speed trap.

This will be calculated by adding the top 4 times within a team, per activity, using combined athlete times from

two runs.

We will ask to borrow 6 forestry radios from BK. Scott is going to groom and fill the bottom of the Shaft for us to

have a nice finish line. Wade is here this weekend, working with alpine kids.
